*What do you need to know about deregistering your partner?*

### ***If you were living together without a registered marriage or civil partnership***

You must fill in this form and send it to us within six months after your relationship ended. If your relationship ended more than six months ago, you will need to get in touch with our Service Desk. Your former partner is entitled to the survivor's pension that you accrued before and during your relationship. Philips Pensioenfond's will inform your former partner once this form has been processed in our systems. If your former partner wishes, they can waive the survivor's pension using the 'Waiver declaration' form, which is available on [www.philipspensioenfond's.nl/en/downloads](http://www.philipspensioenfond's.nl/en/downloads). The law does not make any arrangements about sharing your retirement pension if you lived together without being married or registering a civil partnership. ### ***If you married or registered your civil partnership abroad***

You must fill in this form and send it to us within six months after your relationship ended. You also need to include the official certificate evidencing that your marriage or civil partnership has ended. Your former partner is entitled to the survivor's pension that you accrued before and during your relationship. Philips Pensioenfond's will inform your former partner once this form has been processed in our systems. If your former partner wishes, they can waive the survivor's pension using the 'Waiver declaration' form, which is available on [www.philipspensioenfond's.nl/en/downloads](http://www.philipspensioenfond's.nl/en/downloads). Your former partner is also entitled to half the retirement pension that you accrued while you were married or were involved in a civil partnership.
